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Special	NOFO	Discussion:
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#### Key takeaways:

- Will require a lot of teamwork for all counties
- Consolidated Application, CoC application, Projects are evaluated, scored, ranked and priority listed, submitted to HUD and then ranked and selected by HUD.
- Rural and Unsheltered Homeless separate applications
- Special NOFO is due 10/20/2022.
- BTG Unsheltered: \$1.81m/3yrs (applies to all 3 BTG Counties)
- BTG Rural: \$1.76m/3yrs (as per appendix b, applies to Hawaii & Kauai Counties only)
- Maude: Some requirements that BTG does not have in place:
  - Agreements with PHA (1 County or all 3?)
  - Agreements from Healthcare providers
  - Working group of Lived-Experience to approve
- Match Requirement = 25% Match for funds
- Collab Applicant/KMNH has to set up projects in esnaps to be able to apply and be scored against other projects applying
- Partnerships with PHA and Healthcare will improve the application score.
- KMNH: The communities that will be applying need to be involved in the putting together this special NOFO application.
- Brandee: Hope Services is considering applying for the Special NOFO.
- BTG needs to develop a process just for this special NOFO: writing the RFP, evaluation committee, etc.
- KMNH is not contracted with BTG to complete this Special NOFO. KMNH would be able to provide the packaging of the Special NOFO and will still represent BTG's application.
- Sharon H: Is there any funding that could pay KMNH for their work in setting up and packaging the Special NOFO?
- KMNH will need significant commitments from BTG Board and applicants to complete the Special and the Regular NOFO that may be due simultaneously.
- Maude: Could KMNH clarify the conflict-of-interest in applicants to participate in creating the RFP, KMNH to consult with HUD
- Maude's ask of BTG Board: Board Members not-applying commit to a Special NOFO working group with weekly meetings to develop the RFP, determine deadlines, identify the evaluation committee, etc. Applicants will also need to submit significant information to support the entire application.
