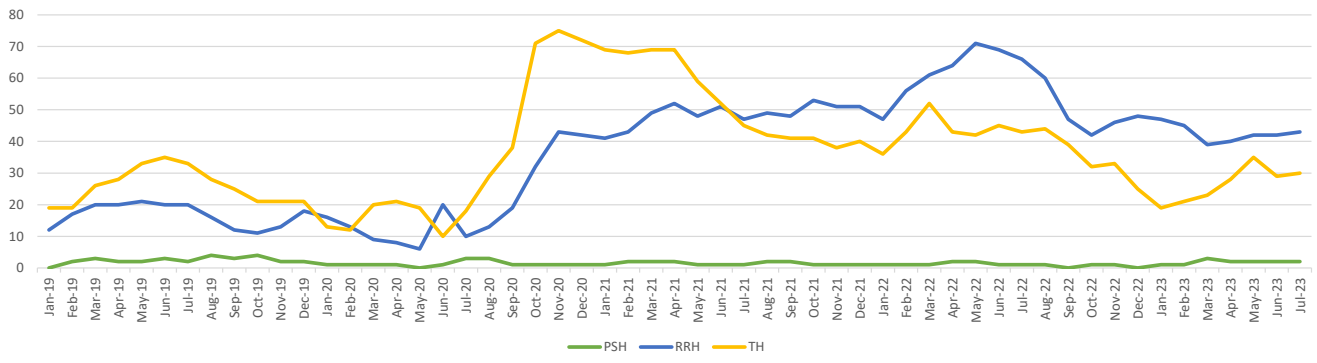

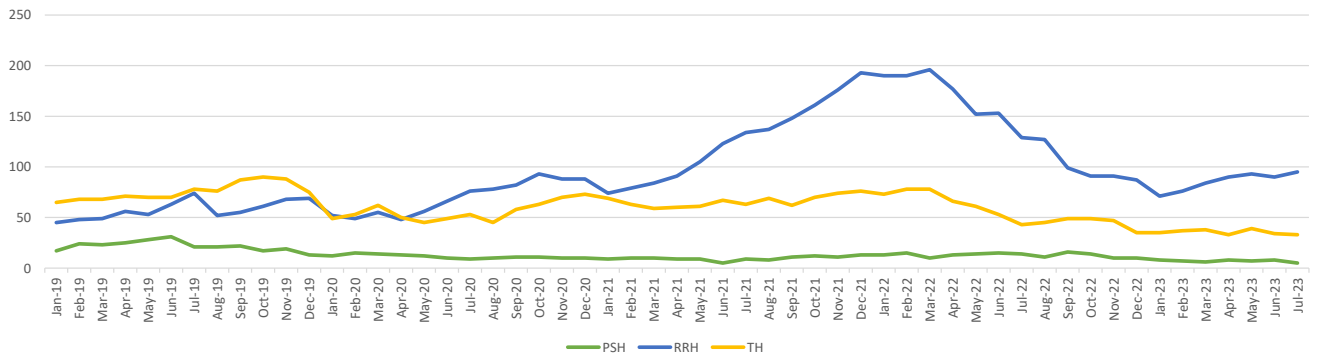
**BNL - Hawaii Active Singles from Section 1.1**



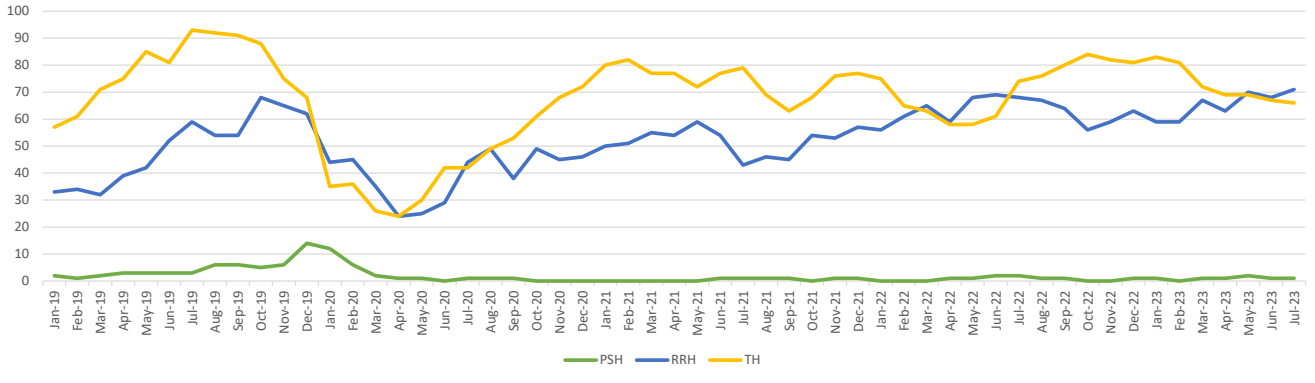
**BNL - Kauai Active Singles from Section 1.1**



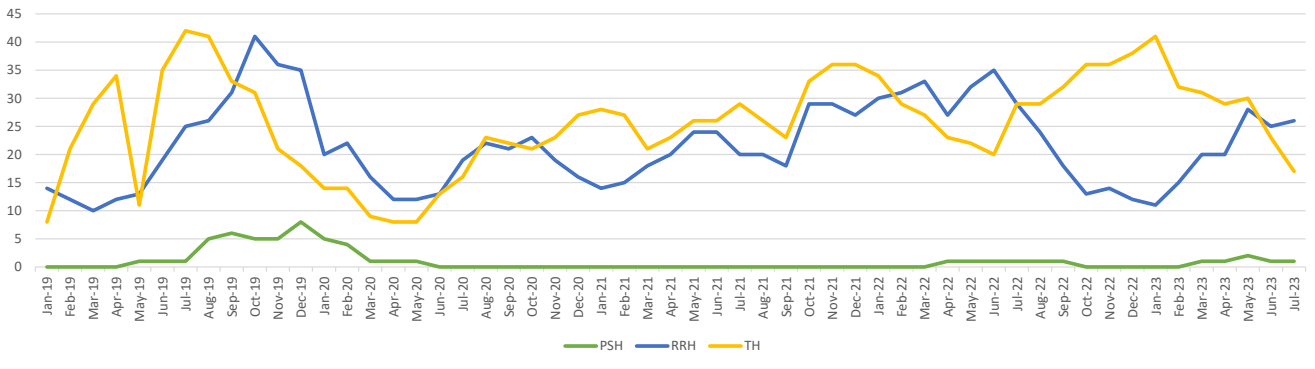
**BNL - Maui Active Singles from Section 1.1**



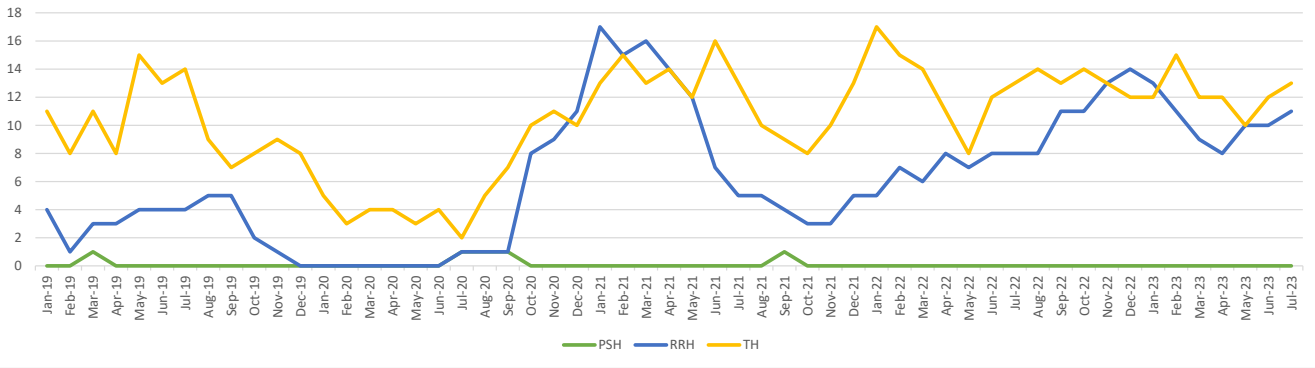
