For February 2021

The HMIS administrative team completed analysis of client exit destinations from HMIS Bridging the Gap program discharge records for the month of February 2021 (n = 218). This analysis presents findings by county, over program type, and by org/program.

The summary tables show the total exits by destination category, along with permanent housing (PH) exit rates. The analysis also includes the total number of exits with unknown exit destination type along with the corresponding exit rates. Exits for Services Only programs are no longer included in this report, as of February 2021.

Key findings of the monthly reporting include:

- In aggregate, the PH exit rate for February was 65%, with 142 of 218 exits leaving to PH destinations, one percentage point higher than in January, when removing Services Only program exits from the analysis (64%).
- Of the 142 exits to PH, Homeless Prevention programs exited 62 clients to PH (44%), Rapid Re-housing programs exited 29 clients to PH (20%), Emergency Shelter (ES) exited 21 clients to PH (15%), Street Outreach programs exited 17 clients to PH (12%), and Permanent Supportive Housing exited 4 clients to PH (3%).
- February PH exit rates descending by county were Hawaii (68%), Maui (64%), and Kauai (63%).
- The PH exit rate was 100% for Homeless Prevention programs in February and 94% for Rapid Re-housing programs; the same rate for HP and a decrease for RRH, compared to January. Due to the inherent nature of these programs, one would expect that these PH exit rates would be near 100%.
- The missing exit data rate for February was 7%, a decrease compared to January (18%).
- Kauai had 9 exits to unknown locations in February, and Maui had 6 exits to unknown destinations.

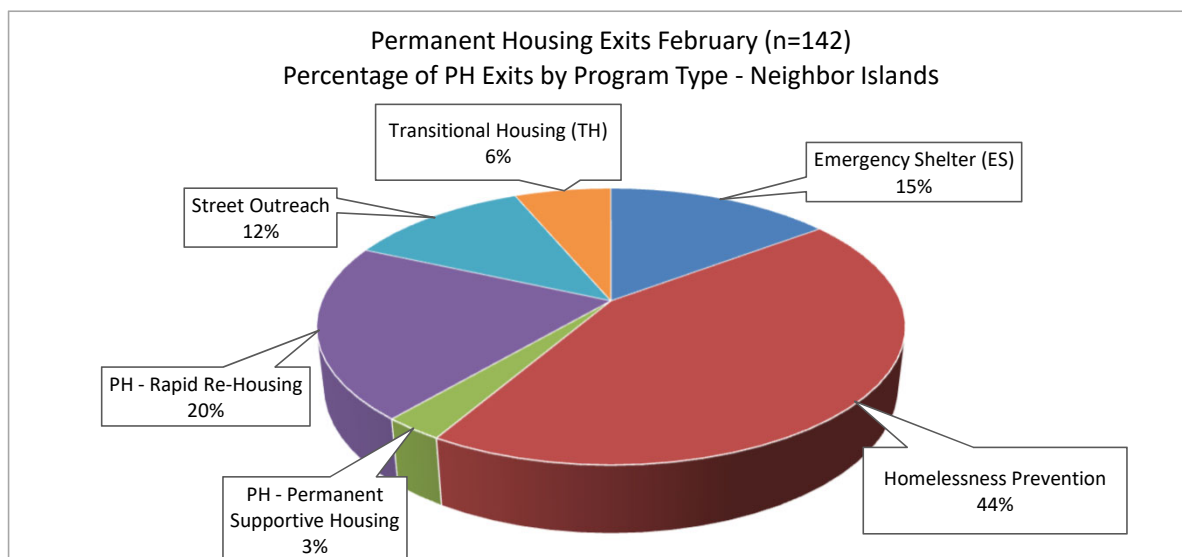

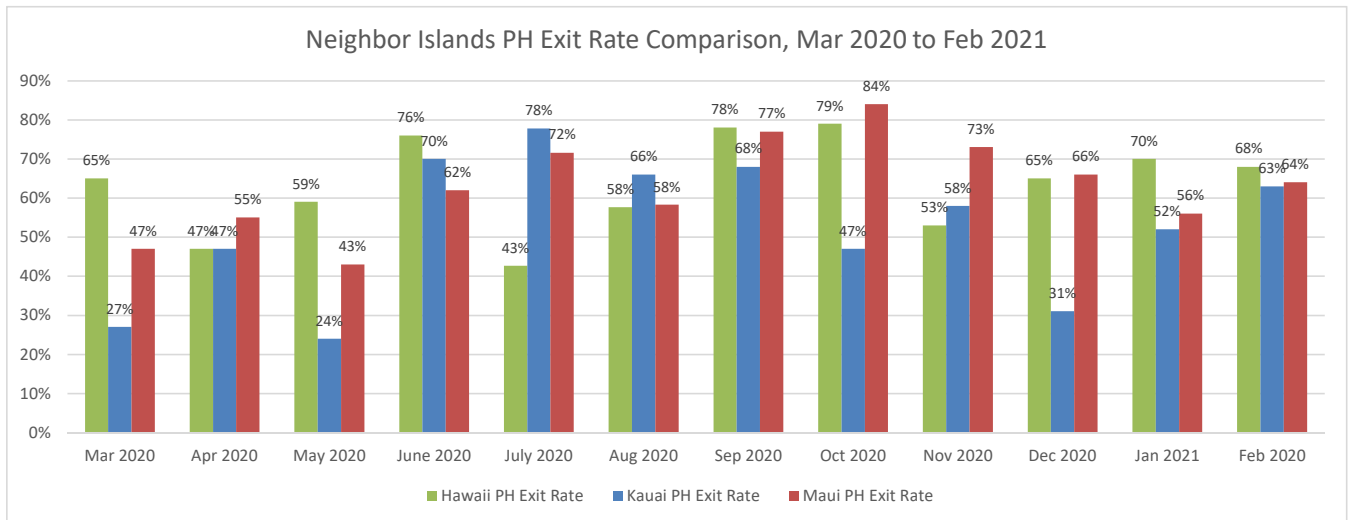
