

Summary of Key Points

Analysis of Exit Destinations by County, Program Type, and Organization

For December 2018

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The HMIS admin team completed analysis of client exit destinations from HMIS program discharge records for the month of December 2018 (n = 1,056). The analysis presents findings by county, over program type, and by org/program.

The summary tables show the total exits by destination category, along with permanent housing exit rates. Analysis also includes the total number of exits with unknown exit destination type along with the corresponding exit rates.

Key findings of the monthly reporting include:

- In aggregate, the PH exit rate for December was 54% with 565 of 1,056 exits leaving to PH destinations, an increase compared to November (51%); December's PH rate is well within the range of 2018 PH rates (41% to 61%); a continued improvement trend since December 2017 (33%).
- Of the 565 PH exits, Rapid Re-Housing exited 213 clients to PH (38%), Homeless Prevention programs exited 144 clients to PH (25%), Emergency Shelter programs exited 99 clients to PH (18%), Transitional facilities exited 67 clients to PH (12%), and Outreach programs exited 23 clients to PH (4%).
- Street Outreach and Emergency Shelter project types should not be evaluated solely on exits to PH. Often, placements into institutional settings, transitional shelters, or residential projects are positive outcomes for these project types and the clients within.
- December PH rates descending by county were Kauai (70%), Maui (62%), Hawaii (53%), and Oahu (49%).
- Homeless Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing projects had the highest PH exit rates (96% and 88% respectively). Due to the inherent nature of these programs, however, one would expect that these rates be near 100%.
- The missing exit data rate remained steady in December 2018 at 13% (134 clients with unknown exits). June 2018 had the lowest rate to date (12%). The missing exit rate first calculated in December 2017 was 34%. Oahu represented 78% (105) of the missing total.
- Oahu and Maui had the greatest proportion of exits to unknown locations in December, with 16% (105 of 666 exits) for Oahu, and 9% (23 of 250 exits) for Maui. ES and Outreach projects accounted for the vast majority of these exits.
- Oahu Street Outreach (34%) and Hawaii Street Outreach (26%) had the highest rates of missing exit data in December.

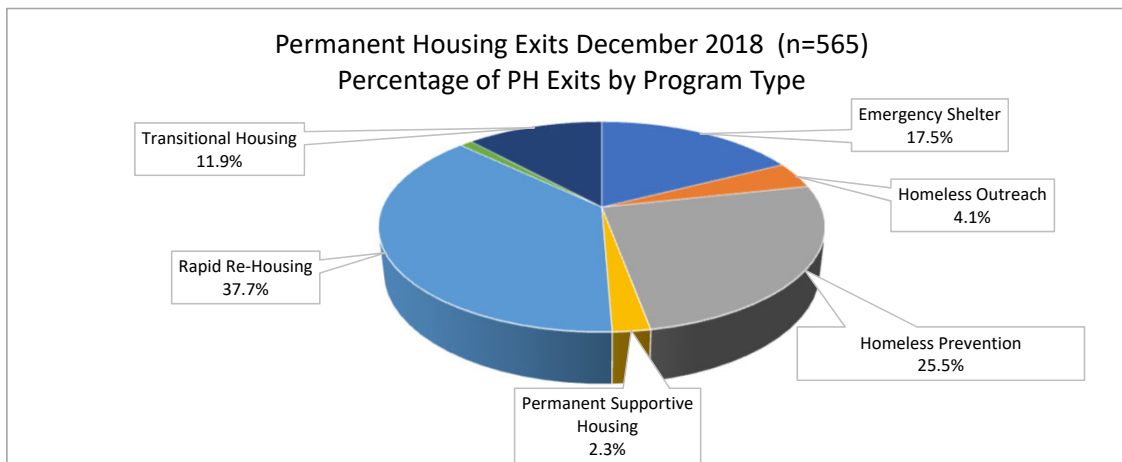
