Re: October 2016 HMIS Monitoring Reports

Attached for your review and dissemination to the two Continuums are the October 2016 HMIS monitoring reports. These reports use data extracted from the HMIS as of the 15th of November or later. The reports follow the format of previous monthly reports and include some additional analysis including veteran census counts, and active outreach counts. Highlights include:

1. Census counts showed 50 programs with end of month census counts outside of the normal utilization range (90% to 110%). Discrepancies include underutilization of HIC facilities as well as programs that report overutilization due to a failure to record discharges or erroneous HIC data. The top five facilities in each area are listed below:

2. The additional veteran census as of Oct 31st shows a total of 251 veterans living in ES/TS facilities on Oahu and 48 living in BOS homeless facilities. The outreach census count reports a total of 259 homeless veterans active in outreach on Oahu and 191 homeless veterans active in outreach on the Neighbor Islands. Total homeless vets active in the HMIS as of the end of October is 749 persons. This number does not include members of veteran families who are not veterans. The January 2016 PIT found a total of 670 homeless veterans, sheltered or unsheltered statewide.
3. Total active outreach as of October 31, 2016 totaled 6,597 including 4,188 in Oahu and 2,409 on the Neighbor Islands. Planning for the PIT counts should work to verify these active lists as a primary activity before and during the PIT count period.
4. Timeliness of data entry averaged approximately 7 days for both intake and discharge. The Timeliness report highlights in RED, programs with timeliness rates over 3 days. Only 88 out of 192, or 46% of programs had a timeliness average of 3 days or fewer.
5. Agencies should review the Length of Stay analysis due to its primary importance as a HUD performance measure. LOS averages should be decreasing to show progress towards the HUD goal.

The attached reports should be reviewed by each CoC and their member agencies.

Report Definitions and Abbreviation Explanations

Header Definitions:

- HIC Beds: Total bed capacity as listed on the 2016 Housing Inventory Count (HIC) submitted to HUD.
- Census on Oct 31st: Report totaling the number of active enrollments in programs in the system on October 31st (last day of report month).
- % HIC Beds: Represents the percent of beds filled as of the census day. The census number divided by the reported maximum bed number. Numbers greater than 100% represent overcapacity or counts that may contain errors (missing discharges).
- Technical Openings: Represents the number of beds open/unused based on comparison of the HIC bed count and the census bed count. May not necessarily represent the actual beds available due to variation in family members per unit, off-line units and other circumstances. Provides a general comparison that can highlight potential issues. If filled or overfilled, value is set to zero.

NL – Not Listed. Either on HIC or in CaseWorthy program listing

NA – Not Applicable

SP – Special Populations that are confidential and not currently reported on CaseWorthy reports.
Special Populations include Domestic Violence, AIDS/HIV and Youth.
