Re: January 2017 HMIS Monitoring Reports

Attached for your review and dissemination to the Continuum agencies are the January 2017 HMIS monitoring reports. These reports use data extracted from the HMIS as of the 15th of February. The reports follow the format of previous monthly reports. An additional report of the percentage of clients recorded as giving consent to HMIS data sharing is included this month. Highlights include:

1. Total active HMIS clients in shelters (ES/TH) at the end of **January totaled 2,812 on Oahu and 748 on the Neighbor Islands for a total of 3,560**. These totals do not include persons at Domestic Violence shelters. These “active clients” totals compare with the 2016 sheltered PIT count of 2,767 on Oahu and 846 on the Neighbor Islands.
2. The number of sheltered veterans totaled **294 Statewide with 256 on Oahu and 38 on the Neighbor Islands**. This compares to the total of 224 on Oahu and 40 on the Neighbor Islands tallied for the 2016 PIT count.
3. A review of the consent to share data of all active records **increased to 55%** overall (selection of “Yes” value), up from 52% as of December 31st. Agencies should work to ensure all programs achieve at least a 70% or higher consent rate.
4. Average data entry timeliness during January is currently reported as **4.7 days for intakes and 5.1 days for exits**. The new performance goal has been set by HPO as 3.0 days as calculated by the CaseWorthy report which translates into 2 days after the day of the intake or exit date. Revised timeliness data for prior months show that agencies are completing some intakes and exits more than 30 days late.
5. Length of stay data show that some emergency and most transitional shelters **exceed** the new HPO performance goals of 60 days (ES) or 90 days (TH) for the average stay.

With the beginning of new shelter and outreach contracts starting February 1st, CPC has requested revised bed capacities for all contracted programs. The HMIS continues to contain too many active Outreach records that need to be closed out, especially as new outreach contracts are beginning this month.
