Re: February 2017 HMIS Monitoring Reports

Attached for your review and dissemination to the Continuum agencies is the February 2017 HMIS monitoring report. The following individual reports are attached with highlight briefs:

- 1) Census summary by Continuum and Statewide (1 page)
 - Significant Statewide decreases in HMIS census including a 10% drop in emergency shelter census (1,563 to 1,411) and a 3.5% drop in transitional shelter census (1,997 to 1,929)
 - The number of persons in Permanent Housing (Statewide) rose slightly from 1,263 to 1,274
- 2) Census report by agency and programs (5 pages)
 - Program-level bed capacity has not been adjusted with new bed capacities from HPO contracts.
 - Total active outreach cases totaled 8,559. An unknown amount of cases are inactive and/or represent clients open in more than one agency or program.
- 3) Consent report for intakes during February 2017 (3 pages)
 - Four agencies achieved consent rates over 90% including Family Promise 100%, Weinberg Village Waimanalo 100%, HOPE Services Hawaii 97%, and KEO 94%.
 - 28 programs had consent percentages of 50% or lower during February. Kalihi-Palama Health Center had the lowest consent rate of 9% (12 out of 128).
- 4) Consent report by program type for intakes during February 2017 (1 page)
 - Report shows large variation in consent by program and county from an over 95% consent rate on the Big Island to a 51% consent rate on Maui.
 - An overall statewide consent rate for new intakes during February of 61%
- 5) Length of Stay by agency and program for exits during February 2017 (3 pages)
 - The average LOS for all 1,268 exits during February was 268 days.
 - The report details the LOS for each of the 84 programs entering exits during February. Some programs had 3 or fewer exits for the LOS calculation.
- 6) Length of Stay by program type for exits during February 2017 (1 page)
 - Among Emergency Shelters, Oahu facilities registered the longest LOS at 117 days, followed by Hawaii at 102 days, Kauai at 58 days, and Maui at 35 days.
 - Among Transitional Shelters, Oahu facilities registered the longest LOS at 299 days, followed by Kauai at 265 days, Hawaii at 161 days, and Maui at 110 days.
- 7) Timeliness (intake and exits) during February 2017 (5 pages)
 - Significant improvements in intake and exit data entry timeliness during February.
 - Intake timeliness averaged 3.96 days, which represent 2.96 days after the intake date.
 - Exit data entry timeliness averaged 4.27 days, which represents 3.27 days after the exit date.
