Re: February 2018 HMIS Monitoring Reports

Attached for your review and dissemination to Continuum agencies is the February 2018 HMIS monitoring report. Below are brief highlights from the attached reports.

1) End of month, February 2018 Census summary by Continuum and Statewide (pp. 2-7)

- The Statewide census for emergency and transitional programs decreased in February 2018 (3,036) compared to January 2018 (3,105). For Oahu, the emergency shelter census decreased from 1,179 in January to 1,098 in February and the transitional facilities census increased slightly from 1,228 to 1,238 in February. For neighbor islands, the emergency shelter census increased slightly from 488 in January to 494 in February, while the transitional facilities census decreased slightly from 210 to 206 in February.
- The total "vacant beds" when compared to the HIC capacity was 716 (ES and TH) and 196 (PSH).
- 36 programs on Oahu and 24 programs on the Neighbor Islands had utilization rates of less than 85% or greater than 110%. These programs are marked in red.
- Statewide Active Outreach clients totaled 1,732; 1,151 on Oahu and 581 on the Neighbor Islands. Outreach clients increased for both CoCs, representing the first increase in several months.
- 2) Consent report for February 2018 (pp. 8-20)
 - VI-SPDAT Assessments: Consent to share data rates for Neighbor Islands and Oahu programs were 86% and 89% respectively. (p. 8)
 - By Name List: Consent to share data rates as of March 1, 2018 was 59% statewide; for Oahu Families (50%) and Singles (57%). Neighbor Island family and singles rates ranged from 57% (Maui family) to 90% (Hawaii singles). (pp. 9-10)
 - For adult program intakes (n=1,017), the statewide consent to share rate decreased to 89% from 90% in January, still representing a significant and continuing increase since February 2017 (55%).
 - Twelve programs (pp. 11-14) had consent rates below 80%. These programs are highlighted in RED.
- 3) Length of Stay by Agency and Program for clients exiting during February 2018 (pp. 21-24)
 - The average LOS for all programs was 186 days (representing 919 exits), an increase compared to January (164 days). If the nine permanent housing program exits are omitted, the average LOS was 176 days.
 - Overall, emergency shelter and services only programs' LOS were the shortest (97 and 99 days).
 PSH and Street Outreach LOS were the longest (1,179 and 279 days).
 - By County, Oahu (209 days) and Maui (181 days) averaged the longest LOS, followed by Hawaii (120 days) and Kauai (76 days). Of note is that the average includes PSH, HP, and RRH projects, which skew the measure.
 - Emergency Shelter LOS ranged from 59 days on Hawaii to 105 days on Oahu.
- 4) Timeliness (entries and exits) during February 2018 (pp. 25-29)
 - Intake Timeliness was 2.09 average days, a decrease compared to 2.58 average days in January.
 - 27 programs (highlighted in RED) averaged more than 3 days to enter intakes.
 - Exit timeliness decreased to 1.5 days on average compared to 2.33 days in January. A significant improvement.
 - 19 programs (highlighted in RED) averaged more than 3 days to enter exits.
