Re: March 2018 HMIS Monitoring Reports

Attached for your review and dissemination to Continuum agencies is the March 2018 HMIS monitoring report. Below are brief highlights from the attached reports.

1) End of month, March 2018 Census summary by Continuum and Statewide (pp. 2-7)

- The Statewide census for emergency and transitional programs increased in March 2018 (3,075) compared to February 2018 (3,036). For Oahu, the emergency shelter census decreased slightly from 1,098 in February to 1,095 in March and the transitional facilities census increased from 1,238 in February to 1,261 in March. For neighbor islands, the emergency shelter census increased slightly from 494 in February to 525 in March, while the transitional facilities census decreased slightly from 206 to 194 in March.
- The total "vacant beds" compared to the HIC capacity was 477 (ES and TH) and 217 (PSH).
- 29 programs on Oahu and 19 programs on the Neighbor Islands had utilization rates of less than 85% or greater than 110%. These programs are marked in red.
- Statewide Active Outreach clients totaled 1,840 including 1,266 on Oahu and 574 on the Neighbor Islands (an increase from February's 1,730 outreach clients). This is due to an increase for Oahu, but a slight decrease for neighbor islands.
- 2) Consent report for March 2018 (pp. 8-20)
  - VI-SPDAT Assessments: Consent to share data rates for Neighbor Islands and Oahu programs were 100% and 95% respectively, an increase compared to February's 86% and 89%. (p. 8)
  - By Name List: Consent to share data rates as of April 3, 2018 was 61% statewide; for Oahu Families (51%) and Singles (59%). Neighbor Island family and singles rates ranged from 76% (Kauai family) to 93% (Hawaii family). (pp. 9-10)
  - For adult program intakes (n=941), the statewide consent to share rate increased from 89% in February to 93% in March, the highest rate in an upward trend since March 2017 (55%).
  - Eight programs (pp. 11-14) had consent rates below 80%. These programs are highlighted in RED.
- 3) Length of Stay by Agency and Program for clients exiting during March 2018 (pp. 21-24)
  - The average LOS for all programs was 173 days (representing 927 exits), a decrease compared to February (186 days). If the 21 permanent housing programs exits are omitted, the average LOS was 146 days.
  - Overall, emergency shelter and homeless outreach programs' LOS were the shortest (94 and 64 days). PSH and TH program's LOS were longest (1,363 and 256 days).
  - By County, Oahu (203 days) and Maui (140 days) averaged the highest LOS, followed by Hawaii (109 days) and Kauai (99 days). Of note is that the average includes PH projects, which skew the statistic.
  - Emergency Shelter LOS ranged from 51 days on Hawaii to 106 days on Oahu.
- 4) Timeliness (entries and exits) during March 2018 (pp. 25-29)
  - Intake Timeliness was 1.99 average days, a slight decrease compared to 2.09 average days in February. 25 programs (highlighted in RED) averaged more than 3 days to enter intakes.
  - Exit timeliness increased to 1.74 average days compared to 1.5 days in February.
  - 31 programs (highlighted in RED) averaged more than 3 days to enter exits.
