Re: March 2020 HMIS Monitoring Reports (Neighbor Islands – Bridging the Gap)

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Attached for your review and dissemination to Continuum agencies is the March 2020 HMIS monitoring report. Below are brief highlights from the attached reports.

1. End of month, March 2020 Census summary by Continuum and Statewide (pp. 2-4)
  - The Neighbor Island census for emergency shelter (ES) and transitional housing (TH) programs decreased in March 2020 (578), compared to February (611), with a slight increase in ES, but a decrease in TH.
  - Over the past six months, the census in ES and TH decreased, but increased in PH programs, with monthly combined census (ES, TH, PH) fluctuating over the six months from 970 in October to 959 in March.
  - The total “vacant beds” compared to the HIC bed capacity was 243 (ES and TH) and 103 (permanent supportive housing – PSH). This is an increase for ES and TH, but a decrease for PSH compared to last month. HIC openings can also vary depending on differences in household size.
  - 25 programs on the Neighbor Islands had utilization rates of less than 85% or greater than 110%. These programs are marked in red.
  - Active outreach clients totaled 391, a decrease compared to February 2020 (417 clients).
2. Consent report for March 2020 (pp. 5-11)
  - VI-SPDAT Assessments: Consent to share data rate for Neighbor Islands was 99%, the same as in January and February 2020.
  - By Name List: Consent to share data rates as of the 4/01/20, BNL cut was 98% for the CoC. March rates included: 100% for Kauai families and singles; 99% for Maui families and singles; 98% for Hawaii families and 95% for Hawaii singles.
  - For adult program intakes entered in March 2020 (n=222), the Neighbor Islands consent to share data rate was 99%, the same as in February 2020.
  - No programs had a consent rate below 80%.
3. Length of stay (LOS) by agency and program for clients exiting during March 2020 (pp. 12-13)
  - The average LOS over all programs was 116 days (representing 314 exits), an increase compared to February 2020 (110 days).
  - The average LOS for Neighbors Islands in March (110 days) was lower than the statewide average LOS for all months from March through August 2019 (181 days), and lower than the average LOS for Neighbor Island programs from September 2019 – March 2020 (126 days).
  - Excluding PSH, the average LOS was 114 days.
  - ES and outreach programs’ LOS were the shortest (74 and 84 days). PSH and transitional housing programs’ lengths of stay were the longest (474 and 205 days).
  - By County Hawaii (153) averaged the longest LOS, followed by Kauai (133 days) and Maui (93 days).
  - Emergency shelter average LOS ranged from 53 days on Maui to 100 days on Hawaii.
  - Transitional housing average LOS ranged from 288 days on Hawaii to 103 days on Kauai.
4. Timeliness (entries and exits) during March 2020 (pp. 14-17)
  - Intake timeliness was 1.46 average days, an increase compared to 1.39 average days in February.
  - 11 programs (highlighted in RED) averaged more than 3 days to enter intakes.
  - Exit timeliness decreased to 1.08 average days, a decrease compared to 1.76 average days in February.
  - 6 programs (highlighted in RED) averaged more than 3 days to enter exits.

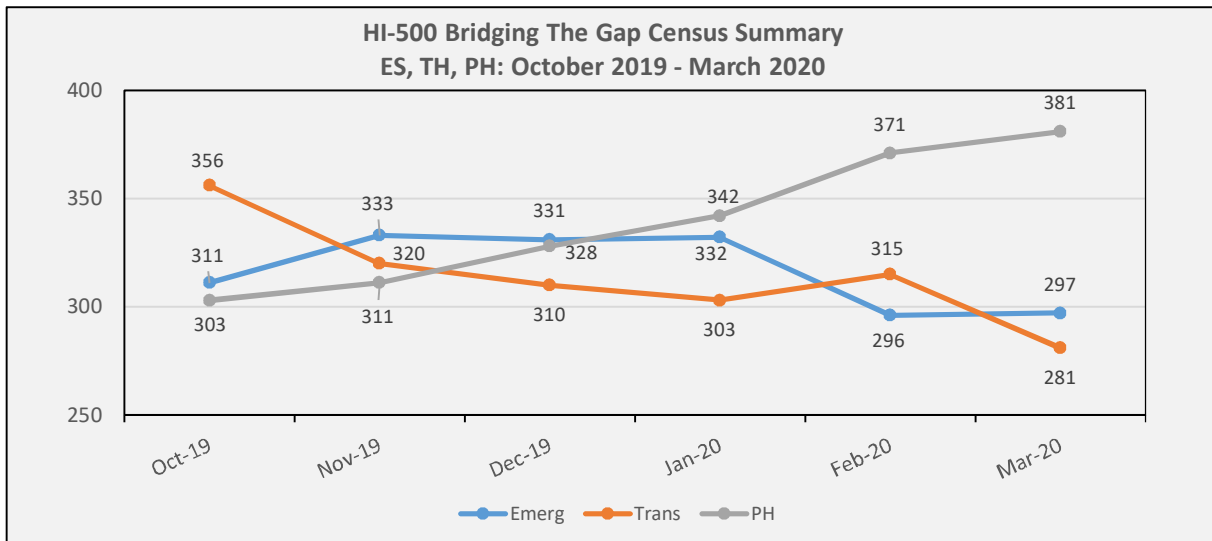

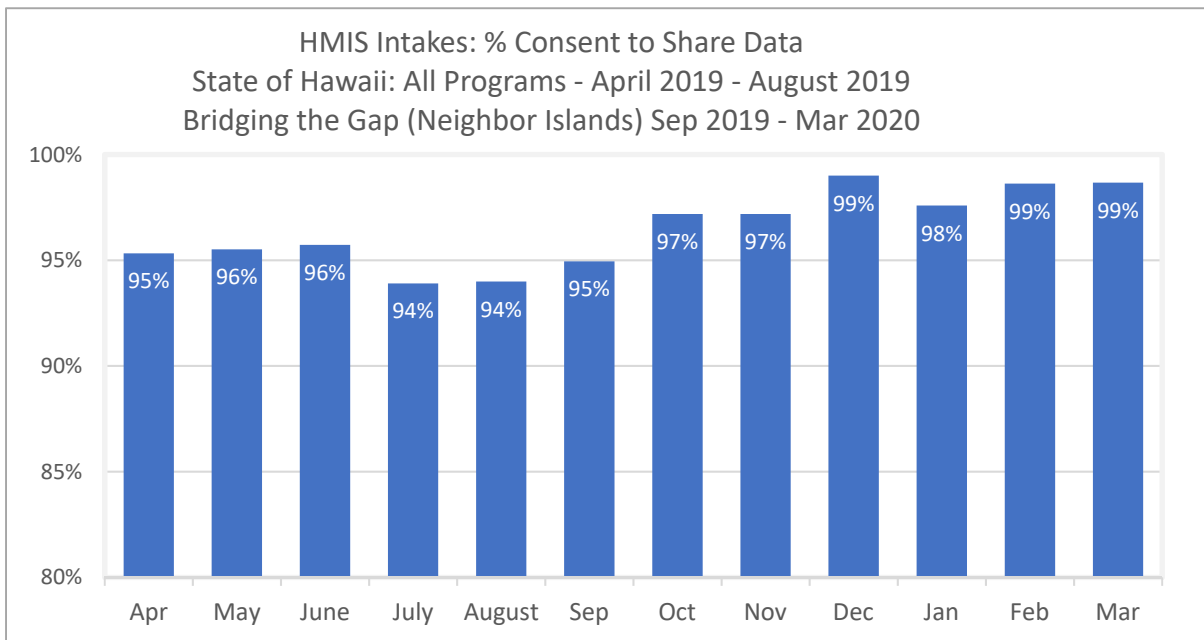
