Re: June 2020 HMIS Monitoring Reports (Neighbor Islands – Bridging the Gap)

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Attached for your review and dissemination to Continuum agencies is the June 2020 HMIS monitoring report. Below are brief highlights from the attached reports.

1. End of month, June 2020 Census summary by Continuum and Statewide (pp. 2-4)
  - The Neighbor Island census for emergency shelter (ES) and transitional housing (TH) programs decreased in June 2020 (519), compared to May (537), with a decrease in both ES and TH.
  - The monthly combined census (ES, TH, PSH) has fluctuated over the past year from a high of 982 in February 2020 to the current low of 911.
  - The total “vacant beds” compared to the HIC bed capacity was 302 (ES and TH) and 91 (permanent supportive housing – PSH). This is an increase for ES and TH, and for PSH compared to last month. HIC openings can also vary depending on differences in household size.
  - 24 programs on the Neighbor Islands had utilization rates of less than 85% or greater than 110%. These programs are marked in red.
  - Active outreach clients totaled 420, an increase compared to May 2020 (382 clients).
2. Consent report for June 2020 (pp. 5-10)
  - VI-SPDAT Assessments: For the second month in a row, the consent to share data rate for Neighbor Islands was 100%.
  - By Name List: consent to share data rates as of the 7/02/20, BNL cut was 99% for the CoC. June rates included: 100% for Hawaii singles, Kauai families and singles and Maui families; 99% for Maui singles and 97% for Hawaii families.
  - For adult program intakes entered in June 2020 (n=313), the Neighbor Islands consent to share data rate was 99%, the same as last month.
  - One program had a consent rate below 80%.
3. Length of stay (LOS) by agency and program for clients exiting during June 2020 (pp. 11-12)
  - The average LOS over all programs was 146 days (representing 347 exits), a slight decrease compared to May 2020 (149 days), but higher than the six-month average for Neighbors Islands LOS (132 days) from January – June 2020.
  - Excluding PSH, the average LOS was 143 days.
  - ES and homeless prevention programs’ LOS were the shortest (99 and 118 days). PSH and services only programs’ lengths of stay were the longest (348 and 287 days).
  - By County Kauai (211) averaged the longest LOS, followed by Hawaii (151 days) and Maui (125 days).
  - Emergency shelter average LOS ranged from 96 days on Maui to 108 days on Kauai.
  - Transitional housing average LOS ranged from 346 days on Kauai to 35 days on Hawaii.
4. Timeliness (entries and exits) during June 2020 (pp. 13-15)
  - Intake timeliness was 1.58 average days, a decrease compared to 2.06 average days in May.
  - 13 programs (highlighted in RED) averaged more than 3 days to enter intakes.
  - Exit timeliness increased to 1.30 average days, compared to 1.08 average days in May.
  - 7 programs (highlighted in RED) averaged more than 3 days to enter exits.

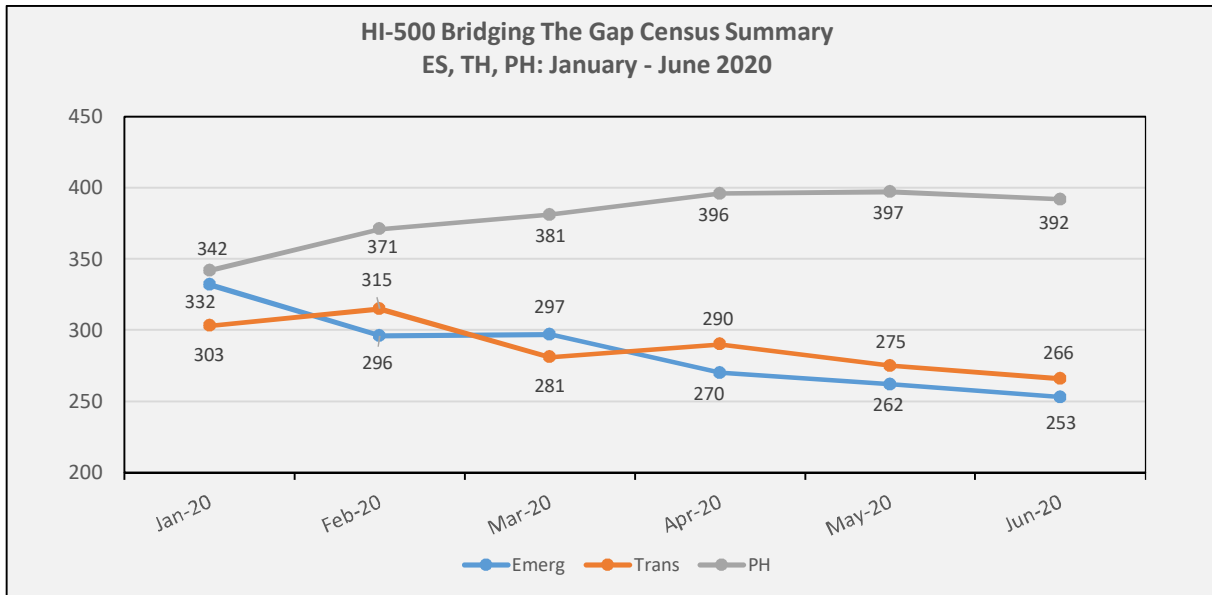

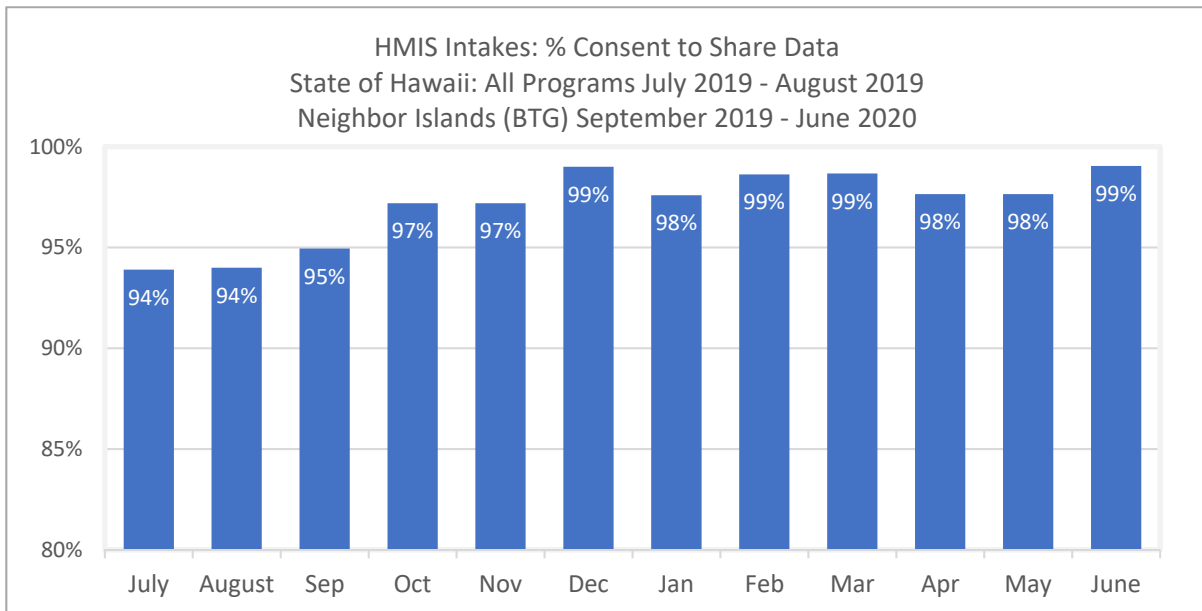
